Medical Missions, Bangladesh

Though we often seem to put our missionaries in a separate category, their life, in many ways, is just like ours! For Nancie, serving in medical ministry, life at the hospital always seems hectic. Several short term doctors have greatly (but only temporarily) relieved the work load, so pray that at least one of them might come back full time!

And, like us, right in the middle of troubles God is working, providing, and answering prayer! Despite the difficulties of a minor war, drought followed by cyclones, flooding, and landslides, and political infighting, the Tribal Association of Churches has had new churches begin in three of the tribal groups, "many receiving new life in response to the Good News and many others giving witness to new life through 'dunking.'" Praise God!

In addition, the Lord has blessed Nancie's Tribal ministry partner as docs declared him cancer-free! Three trips into the hills in two months have revealed his returning energy and joy as he brought word of a softening of hearts! Praise and thanks be to God!
