## MISSIONARY SPOTLIGHT

### **James & Coletta Morsey**                      **Arriba Directors, Santiago, Chile**

This is the first year that Arriba has taken place in Chile, and students Anna and Rachel are doing great. They have completed their course studies and are now doing practical ministries in Chile, in Spanish.

When they first arrived last May both girls had a very tough time with culture shock and learning the language. They just completed one month teaching at a Word of Life camp for children and teens in southern Chile and one has expressed the desire to return and teach again next year. There is also the possibility of teaching English to children at a Missionary school for one or two years.

Their final month in Chile will be spent doing evangelistic outreach to children. They will work along with Coletta and the Morsey's latest church plant with a special Easter outreach and other opportunities in parks and town plazas. They and the Morsey's will fly back to the States in mid April and three new students will join James and Coletta to return to Chile for a year in the Arriba program. Pray for these new students, Dustin, David and Demi that the culture shock and language studies would not be overwhelming and that their host families would be finalized.
