MISSIONARY SPOTLIGHT

Robert & Kim Clark Equipping Leaders in the Philippines

Since 2013, the Clarks have been partnering closely with Filipino and other missionaries. Robert has served with the seminary faculty and as a member of the Board of Trustees of Baptist Bible Seminary and institute alongside the Pastoral Ministry Department as a professor. This ministry has been in Theological Education, Equipping and Mentoring for the development of a new generation of pastors, preachers, Bible teachers, evangelists and missionaries in practical ministry, outreach and discipleship.

The Clarks have moved to Washington and are working from there. Robert very much enjoys teaching and mentoring. He is in contact almost daily with his students. Enrollment is climbing which is exciting to see. The hotspot for missions calling and ministry lately continues to be Cambodia, especially for the young men.

Robert is grateful to the Lord for using his courses to prepare Filipinos for ministry. He has created and taught 23 courses in the last 10 years and seen over 1,000 seminarians graduate into church ministries.

- For the Lord to use Robert and Kim in the training of a new generation of Filipinos for the expansion of the gospel and churches.
- For the seminary's needs for enhancing and enriching of the students and the physical needs of renovations and construction projects on campus.
- For the ongoing health challenges of Robert and Kim. They are seeking new doctors in their new location. Robert has recovered well from his stroke and heart valve surgery. Kim needs prayer as even though she is doing well, there is still concern and the doctors are watching the cyst on her pancreas and also trying to locate the shunt that caused her stroke.
