MISSIONARY SPOTLIGHT

Nancie Dellaganna

Medical Missions, SE Asia

Greetings from Thailand where Nancie D. flies yearly for health check-ups! So far, all exams and tests show good health! In addition, the hospital staff has successfully finished their Spring Field Council meetings. We can praise God for answering prayers to strengthen tribal pastors through two recent conferences led by one of our CARBC pastors! The 40th Awana Anniversary celebration was also an amazing display of God's work in Asia.

At the same time MCH, the hospital where Nancie serves, has struggled to keep adequate medical staff. Not only have two families left whose children were struggling to adapt, but an extended family emergency removed another staff member.

In Nancie's own words: "We are having visa problems. My visa ends 14 May. Then, like a lot of people, I will be without a visa until July at the very earliest, probably later. We stay here by government permission with 5 year Pro Formas. Through those we get our security clearance, work permits and visas. The current Pro Forma ends 30 June. No one knows when the actual acceptance of the new Pro Forma will come and paperwork for new work permits and visas can begin.

How we can pray:

- That Nancie's security clearance comes through before the end of June.
- The new Pro Forma to be accepted quickly.
- Everyone's paperwork to be processed quickly and without problems. (A partner organization has had 4 rejected and 2 have had to leave, with the other 2 in process for leaving.)
- Continue to pray about the trouble in the hills that puts people in great danger and severely limits travel.
- The Coffee project is in process of approval for the next year of work. Pray the unrest and danger does not keep the farmers from tending their coffee gardens these next few months.
